Varieties

Assyrtiko, Single Vineyard

Type

White, Dry

Produced from the Greek variety Assyrtiko. The grapes come from a selected plot on the slopes of mount Menoikio at an altitude of 550 meters, where low yields per acre prevail.

Vinification

Whole-bunch pressing is followed by skin-contact at low temperature and fermentation in small inox and oak tanks. The wine matures with the fine lees for 6 months.

Characteristics

Bright, green-yellow color. On the nose discreet aromas of white flowers, citrus and lemon peel combined with a sense of minerality. It is a full-bodied wine with a high and refreshing acidity, notes of citrus, stone and chalk dominating in the mouth and its long aftertaste. Ready to drink, but with long aging potential.

Serving Temperature

8 - 10°C

Food Pairing

Small fish and fresh Mediterranean salads, as well as pastas (with pesto) and a wide selection of fatty cheese.
